If you're Happy and you Know it

If you're happy and you know it – quitar chords (n G)

C / C / G(7) / G(7)

If you're happy and you know it, clap your hands. Clap, Clap.

/ G(7) / G(7) / C / C

If you're happy and you know it clap your hands. Clap, Clap.

/ F / F / C / C

If you're happy and you know it, then you really ought to show it

/ G(7) / G(7) / C / C / If you're happy and you know it clap your hands. Clap, Clap.

NOTES:

- This song is in 6/8 or 'march' time, which means a strong beat followed a weaker beat in each 'bar' or 'measure' Count ' $\mathbf{1} 2 \mathbf{1} 2$ ' as you play. (In fact, it is $\mathbf{1}$ -2-3- $\mathbf{4}$ -5-6 ... but you only really feel the 1 and 4!)
- The chord name is placed on the first beat each time, followed by a stroke to indicate your strum. (The chord names and strums have been carefully placed above the appropriate syllables in the song.)
- To start the song, strum the 'C' chord and then pluck the 5th string (where your 3rd finger is pressing the 3rd fret) to get your starting note.
