





NOTES:

- This song is in 6/8 or 'march' time, which means a strong beat followed a weaker beat in each 'bar' or 'measure' Count ' $\mathbf{1} 2 \mathbf{1} 2$ ' as you play. (In fact, it is $\mathbf{1}$ -2-3- $\mathbf{4}$ -5-6 ... but you only really feel the 1 and 4!)
- The chord name is placed on the first beat each time, followed by a stroke to indicate your strum. (The chord names and strums have been carefully placed above the appropriate syllables in the song.)
- To <u>start the song</u>, strum the 'G' chord and then pluck the 4th (open D) string to get your starting note, and then the 3rd (open G) string for 'happy'.
